When assigning a radio frequency other than the normal dispatch net, provide the assigned field units with the channel name (for example: White 1, Yellow, CALCORD, etc.)

It may, depending upon circumstances, also be necessary to provide the frequency. For instance, out of county resources assigned to a local tactical net would need the channel name and the frequency.
