

Supervisor, and UCSC of the activation. CDF will automatically receive a tear-and-run printout.

- 2.3 Once all audible tones have transmitted, dispatchers will broadcast, *"All Santa Cruz Hazardous Materials Team personnel respond to a HazMat incident located at _____. Requested by _____ Fire Department. Further to follow."*
- 2.4 As individual units go enroute, dispatchers will clear the associated pseudo unit. Ex: E3411 goes enroute, attach them to the call and clear the pseudo unit "CFHAZ". Provide any pertinent updates (including all information in section 2.1) to responding units.
- 2.5 After Z2560 goes enroute, provide them with all of the pertinent information from section 2.1.
- 2.6 Dispatchers **must also** send a text page to all County Chiefs. This will be accomplished by utilizing the 'TN' command of CAD.
 - 2.6.1 Dispatchers should include the incident location and information from section 2.1 of this procedure in the text page. Example: "SCHMIT team respond to a hazmat incident fuming garbage truck at 7 Erba Lane, Scotts Valley."
 - 2.6.2 SCHMIT members should respond directly to the incident, there is no need to notify NetCom of their response.
- 2.7 The Incident Commander will be periodically updated about the status of dispatched/responding units. For any significant updates dispatchers will generate a second text (TN) page to all County Chiefs.
- 3.0 Procedure for Off Duty Personnel
 - 3.1 The Incident Commander will evaluate the resources needed to determine if more personnel are needed.
 - 3.2 If needed, the Incident Commander will request that all off duty SCHMIT personnel be paged to respond to the scene. This will be accomplished by utilizing a City Watch notification.
 - 3.3 Off duty SCHMIT team members will phone and advise their response status which will be entered into the detail as a comment. The SCHMIT team leader shall be periodically updated as to the status of the off duty members.
