1.0 Policy

The transporting of females by male law enforcement officers may expose officers and agencies to inherent risks of claims. To reduce these risks, male law enforcement officers must take special procedural precautions.

2.0 Procedure

For the male officer's protection against claims of improper conduct, the officer will advise dispatch that he is transporting a female and will provide the following information:

- Location
- Destination
- Starting mileage
- Ending mileage

Record this information on the dispatch incident and acknowledge by announcing the time. If the transport is not part of dispatch incident, create one.
