When receiving a report that something has collided with a structure (a tree, vehicle, etc.) and there are no other emergency circumstances resulting from the collision, the correct incident type is "collision with a structure".

If the collision has caused other emergency circumstances, the correct type code for the circumstance will be used. For example:

Confirmed structure, if the structure is on fire Wires down, if the collision has caused wires to fall Gas leak, if the collision has ruptured a gas line Rescue, if a person is trapped Vehicle accident with injuries, if a person is injured Medical, if a person is injured.

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
