





1.0 Purpose

- 1.1 To provide guidelines for Computer Software Licensing in accordance with the Manufacturer’s Specifications in the End User License Agreement (EULA).

2.0 Computer Software Licensing

- 2.1 All computers owned and operated by SCCECC will be registered with the manufacturer to ensure that they are operated in accordance with the manufacturer’s specifications, licensing, and warranty requirements.
- 2.2 All software shall be licensed and registered with the software developer. No unlicensed copies of any copyrighted software will be used in the Center.

3.0 Annual Software Audit

- 3.1 It will be the responsibility of the Systems Unit to perform an annual software audit on all workstations and servers owned and operated by SCCECC.
- 3.2 If unlicensed software is found on the workstations or servers, it will be removed by Systems Unit personnel unless a legitimate license is produced. Said produced license will then be held in the Systems Unit Software Inventory.
